Message from the Principal



It is with pleasure that I prepare to address the community of St Mary's Catholic School at the conclusion of the 2017 academic year. Being Principal of such a high achieving school, within a community that

continues to astound us all means that there is no shortage of reasons to celebrate and no shortage of motivation from which to speak.
